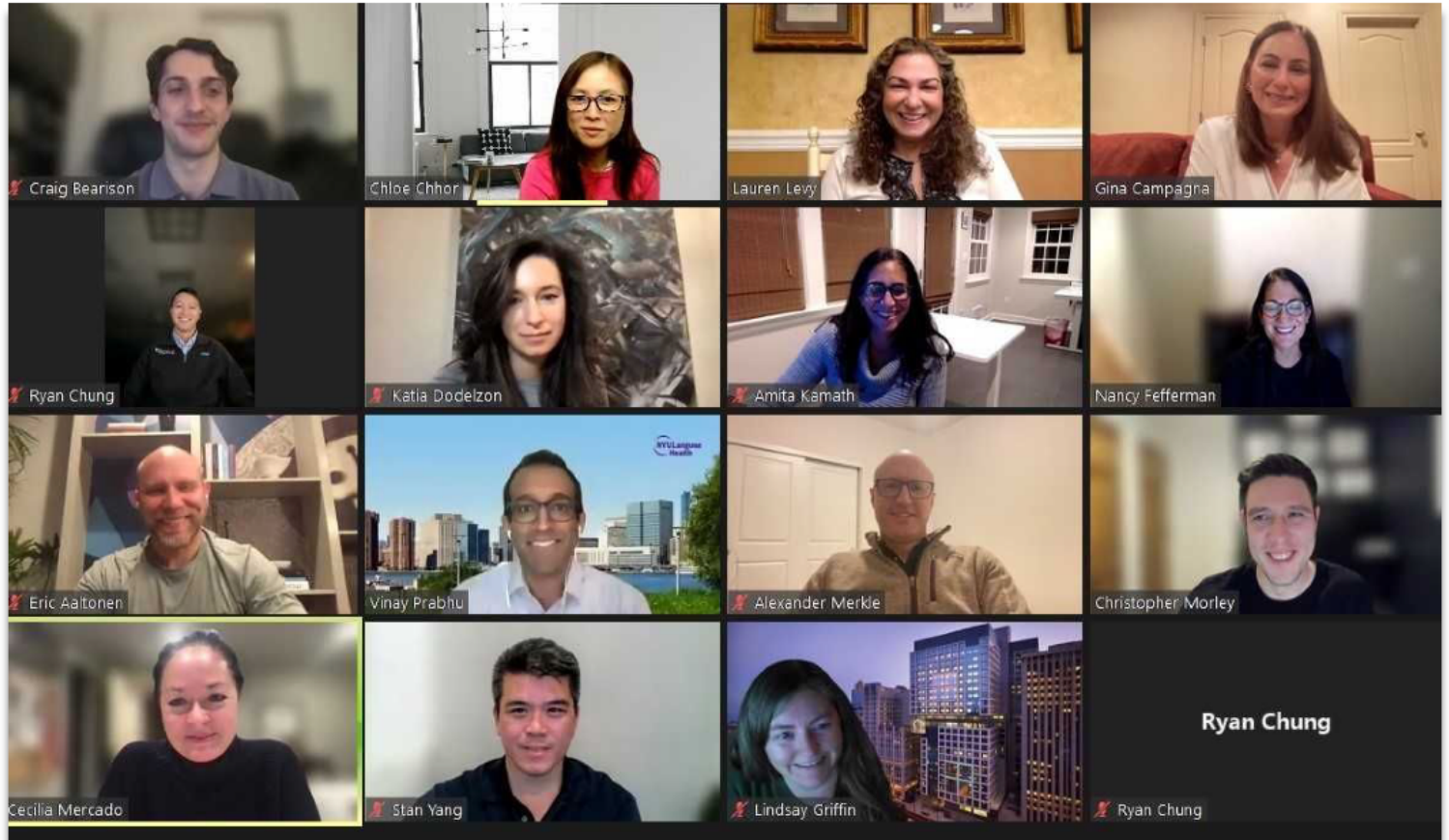
### Alumni Society Reception at the RSNA
